BACKGROUND

The Board exists to identify local transportation service needs, and to give information, advice, and direction to the Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC), Medical Transportation Management, Inc. who coordinates transportation disadvantaged services in Martin County, and to the State Transportation Disadvantaged Commission in Tallahassee.
