BACKGROUND

The East Coast Greenway is a proposed, and partially existing, 3,000 mile long multipurpose trail stretching from Maine to Key West, FL. There are plans for an additional 2,000 miles of complementary routes that would link key cities and other areas of interest. According to the East Coast Greenway website (www.greenway.org), approximately one-fourth of the corridor is currently in place. The East Coast Greenway is partially existing in Martin County and currently provides connectivity to the Savannas Preserve, Seabranh Preserve, and Jonathan Dickinson State Park. The most recently designated portion of the ECG, within Martin County is 2.8 miles (Seabranh Phase II). The most recently constructed portion of the trail, is a 2.5 mile segment, stretching from the Palm Beach County Line, to the entrance of Jonathan Dickinson State Park.

ISSUES

At the May 21, 2014 Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) meeting, members of the East Coast Greenway Alliance, FDOT, Community Partners and local municipality staff members will have a discovery session for the future alignment of the Martin County segment for the remaining portions of the East Coast Greenway. Subsequently, staff will conduct detailed, feasibility exercises for future discussion and ultimately, incorporation into the 2014 updates of the 2012 Bicycle and Pedestrian Action Plan for future implementation.

The East Coast Greenway Alliance is arranging a public event (2015) in Martin County to stimulate interest and support for the project. MPO Staff has provided the ECG Alliance with contact information of local stakeholders, community partners, and municipal leaders to coordinate an outreach efforts and future collaboration.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Provide input for the feasibility of potential alignment routes.

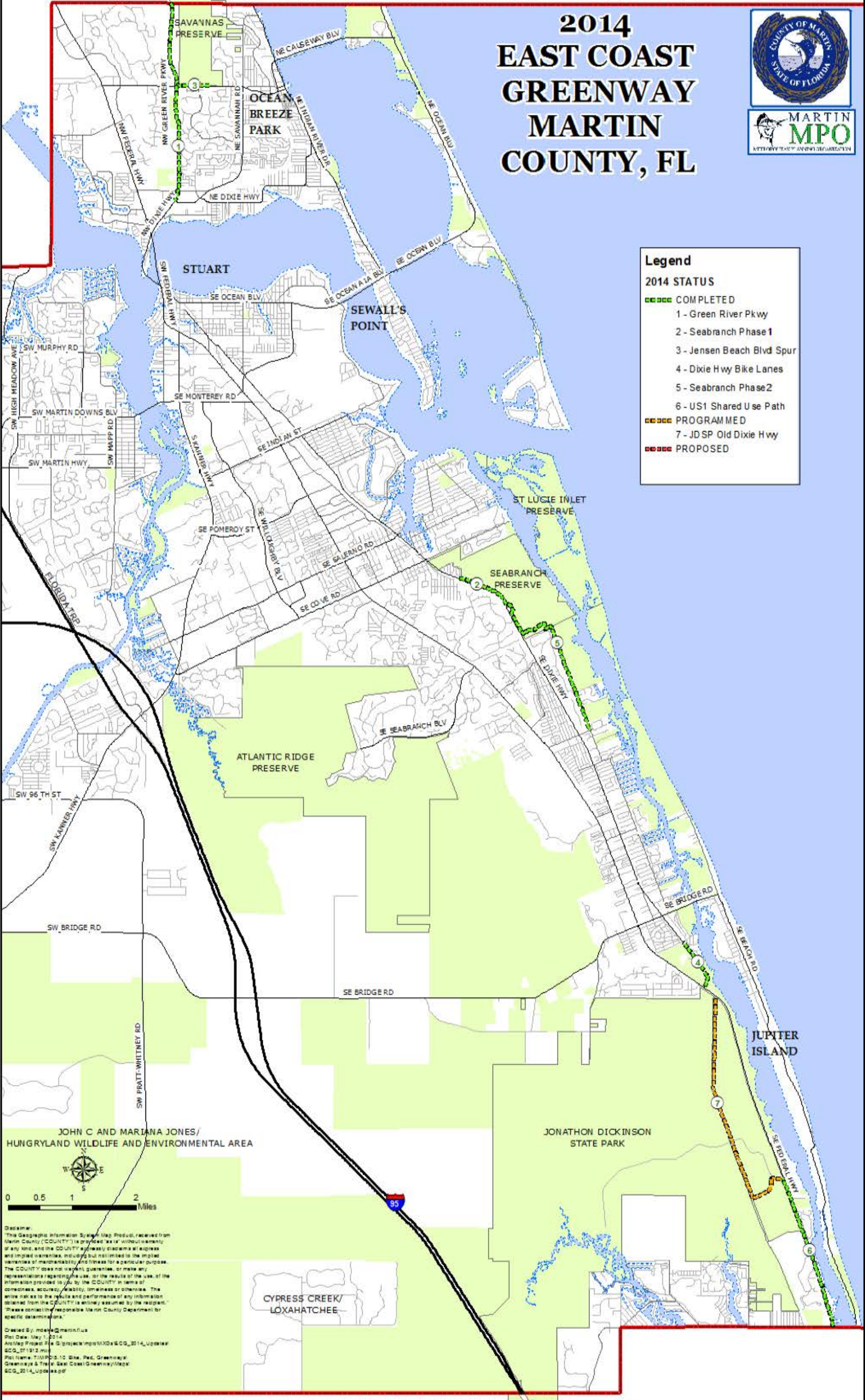
